The Rev. Johanna Marcure called the meeting to order at 6:30

#### #1. Turning to Christ, Session Two: Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

- Jill Shurtleff and Cindy Chatell lead the Chapter 2 discussion from the Pilgrim
- Lynette Cunningham and John Holmes volunteered to read Chapter 3 and discuss during the July Vestry Meeting.

#### #2. Reviewed May 18, 2019 Vestry Minutes

Noted revisions made.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes with changes noted from the May 16, 2019 meeting. All agreed, no opposed. Jill, Susan and Lynette are sustaining vote due to meeting absence.

#### #3. Rev. Johanna Updates

- Episcopal Update Cannon John Alexander was been suspended for a period of 1 year.
- Discussion Member letter received regarding not receiving blessed palms during Saturday evening mass and initiating an Easter vigil.
- Summer worship update Posted new 9:00 am worship schedule between July 7<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day.
- Rental Policy Steve Gaddes will create a rental policy to rental our tables and chairs.
   Policy will be limited to parishioners.

• Stewardship – Reinstate the Worship Committee to discuss new ideas, events, and holiday memorial planning throughout the course of the year. Volunteers include Susan Newkirk, Gail Harrison and Lynette Cunningham.

Motion was made and seconded that future holiday memorial funds be directed toward specific ministries as designated by the Vestry. All agreed, no opposed.

**#4. Rectory improvements** – Rev Johanna has updated downstairs bathroom, replaced kitchen floor and fresh paint in specific areas.

Other improvements needing attention:

- o Refrigerator is leaking Steve Gaddes will review on Saturday
- Front screen door needs replacing
- Landscaping is overgrown and difficult to maintain
- Vestry Committee to review next steps and search for a liaison between the Rectory and Vestry to provide a list of continuous improvements on the property.
- **#5.** Rev. Johanna will be on vacation between August 4<sup>th</sup> thru 18<sup>th</sup> and August 26<sup>th</sup> thru Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>. Jane will search for supply clergy during this time.
- **#6.** Pat will be paid for the 6 weeks she will be out. Back up organist will also be paid during his tenor.
- **#7.** Jane's review has been conducted and she is meeting expectations.

Motion was made and seconded that Jane's salary be increased by \$1.00 per hour starting the first of July, 2019. All agreed, no opposed.

**#8. Turkey Supper Update** – Recommended that the cost per ticket increase to \$15.00. Cost for children will remain the same.

Motion was made and seconded approve Turkey Supper Chairs recommendation to increase the adult ticket price to \$15.00. All agreed, no opposed.

**#9. Holiday Bazaar** – Jill Shurtleff has located a potential Co-Chair. Will provide information shortly

#### **#10.** Providence Water Supply Update

- Trinity will not be able to rent out our facility at this time.
- Application for special use has been withdrawn
- Priority to review other possibilities to use the space to help supplement our budget

#### #12. Property Committee – John Holmes provided an update.

- Plan has been outlined to improve snow removal process.
- Would like to move 4 Shrubs (winterberry) so that mowing can be easily performed. Shrubs will be relocated on the property.
- Painting has been a slow process and parishioner safety is a concern. Backside of the church is in bad condition.
  - John to obtain 3 quotations to vinyl side the backside of the church and steeple

#### #13. Treasurer Report - YTD May, 2019

- Credit cards received from Navigant
  - Purchase receipts are to be kept and forwarded to Trinity's office.

Motion was made and seconded that parishioners with a Trinity Church credit card will be allowed to hold card on their possession. All approved, no opposed.

- Alter Guild Tithes and Pledges are not meeting budget. Suggestion made to update the
  congregation on our YTD Tithes and Pledges receipts vs. Budget. Pledge statements
  will be sent out the end of June. Capitol reminders will be sent out in September, 2019.
- Food Closet is running back on budget.
